# CHARLES FRANK MACKINNON

1st/6th, King's African Rifles who died on 14 June 1919 Age 36

Son of Charles and Mary A. Mackinnon (nee Wishart), of 13, Taylor St., Moonee Ponds, Victoria, Australia. Served with 5th Mounted Rifles (Imperial Light Horse), Nov., 1914-June, 1915, in German South-West Africa, and with 7th Regt. South African Inf., Nov., 1915-Feb., 1917. Gazetted Oct., 1916; also served with Ruga Ruga Scouts. Born at Percydale, Victoria, Australia.
