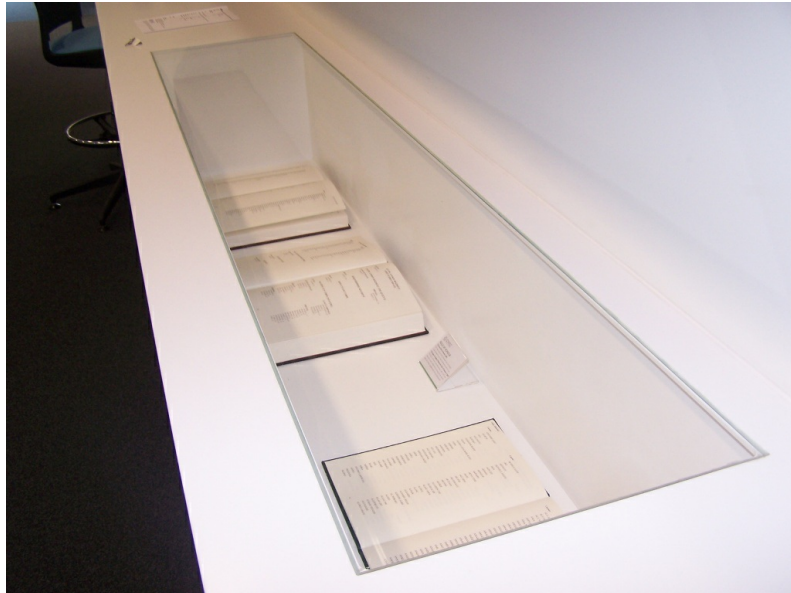
Commanding, 21st Prince Albert Victor's Own Cavalry (F.F.) (Daly's Horse) who died on 29 April
