Distinguished Service Order, Three times Mentioned in Despatches

188th Bde., Royal Field Artillery who died on 30 July 1916 Age 35

Son of Lt. Col. Frederick Octavius Leggett, (Late R.A.O.D.) and Maria Leggett, of High Grange, Hythe; husband of Mary Leggett, of Stonepitts, Ryde, Isle of Wight.
