SIR FREDERICK GRANT BANTING

Knight Commander of the Order of the British Empire, Military Cross

Royal Canadian Army Medical Corps who died on 21 February 1941 Age 48

Son of Mrs. W. J. Banting, of Alliston; husband of Lady Banting, of Toronto. F.R.S., F.R.C.S., F.R.C.P., D.Sc. (McGill) University, LL.D. Awarded Nobel Prize 1923, Scott Medal 1924, Cameron Prize (Edin.) 1927, Flavelle Medal of R.C.S. 1934, Apothecaries Medal (Lond.) 1934, Starr Gold Medal (C.M.A.) 1936. Also served in the 1914-18 War.
