Order of the Medjidie 4th Class. Elder son of the late John Robert and Margaret Christie, of Baynton House, Llandaff, Glam.; husband of Florence Violet Christie, of Somerset Lodge, Knowles Hill, Newton Abbot, Devon. Served in the Soudan Campaign, 1898 (Mentioned in Despatches), and in the South African Campaign, 1899-1902 (Mentioned in Despatches).
