OF AMERICA WHO DIED AS PRISONERS OF WAR IN JAPAN. THE NAMES OF 284 ARE
INSCRIBED ON THESE WALLS. THE IDENTITY OF OTHER 51 COMRADES IS UNKNOWN.
THERE BE OF THEM THAT HAVE LEFT A NAME BEHIND THEM THAT THEIR PRAISES MIGHT
