IN THE URN BELOW REST THE ASHES OF 535 SAILORS, SOLDIERS AND ARMEN OF THE  
BRITISH COMMONWEALTH, THE KINGDOM OF THE NETHERLANDS AND THE UNITED STATES  
OF AMERICA WHO DIED AS PRISONERS OF WAR IN JAPAN. THE NAMES OF 284 ARE  
INSCRIBED ON THESE WALLS. THE IDENTITY OF THIR 51 COMRADES IS UNKNOWN  
THERE BE OF THEM THAT HAVE LEFT A NAME BEHIND THEM THAT THEIR PRAISES MIGHT  
BE REPORTED AND SOME THERE BE WHICH HAVE NO MEMORIAL. BUT THEIR RIGHT-  
EQUSSNESS HATH NOT BEEN FORGOTTEN AND THEIR GLORY SHALL NOT BE BLOTTED OUT
