45th Bde., Royal Field Artillery who died on 27 May 1918 Age 24

Croix de Guerre with Palms (France). Son of Horatio Arthur and Mary Judith Massey. Born in New Zealand. B.A. (Cantab.). Mentioned, with his Bty., in General Berthelot's Ordre General No. 351 of 16th July, 1918; the Bty. also received the Croix de Guerre. His brother George Hocken Massey also fell.
