No. 2 Training Wing, Royal Air Force who died on 23 February 1919 Age 27

Son of John George and Maria Hammond, of 61, Cromwell Avenue, Highgate, London. Mentioned four times in American Despatches. Joined H.M Forces 1914; served 15 months in France; 1 year in U.S.A Army Balloon Schools, Fort Omaha and San Antonio, training American airmen, 1917-18. Born in Essex.
