# FRANK HARRINGTON SULLIVAN

216th Sqdn., Royal Air Force who died on 29 March 1919 Age 20

Died as a result of accident to aeroplane whilst in service conveying mail from Marquise, France, to Army of Occupation, Cologne. Son of Andrew T. Sullivan and Mary E. Kavanagh Sullivan, of Brooklyn, N.Y., U.S.A. Previous to enlistment was a student at Stevens Technical Institute, Hoboken, N.J., preparing for profession of mechanical engineer.
