FRANCIS NEWTON ALLEN CROMIE

Companion of the Bath, Distinguished Service Order

(Naval Attache, Petrograd), Royal Navy who died on 31 August 1918 Age 36

Chevalier, Legion of Honour; Order of St. Vladimir with Swords (Russia); Cross of St. George (Russia). Son of the late Capt. F. C. Cromie, Hampshire Regt. (Consul General, Dakar), and of Mrs. Lennard (formerly Cromie), husband of Mrs. Cromie, of 9, Old Park Rd., Clapham Common, London. Awarded Royal Humane Society's Medal (1906). Served in Boxer Rebellion, 1900
(Mentioned in Despatches).
