1st Bn., Irish Guards who died on 04 July 1916 Age 30

Born at Limerick. Son of the Rev. John Theodore Norris Lee and Mary Lee, of Hatfield Vicarage, Harlow, Essex. Joined the Tenth Regiment Mounted Rifles, Sept., 1914, and fought against the rebels in the Orange Free State. Transf. 1915, to the Kalahari Horse and served in the German South West African Campaign.
