2nd/4th Bn., London Regiment (Royal Fusiliers) who died on 26 October 1917 Age 32

Son of J. Gordon Langton and Emily Langton, of 9E, Hyde Park Mansions, London; husband of Una M. Langton, of "Glendura," 92, Hornsey Lane, London. A pupil of Professors Sevcik (Prague), Wirth (Berlin) and Auer (Russia). First initiate of the Gordon Langton Lodge, No.3069. (Unusually, the personal inscription on his headstone consists of a piece of music).
