1st Bn., East Surrey Regiment who died on 08 September 1914 Age 37

Son of the late Col. J. T. Whish and of Mrs. M. B. Goodair (formerly Whish), of "Haven Cottage," Leysdown, Kent; husband of the late Evelyn Ann Whish (nee Wood). Born at Calcutta; joined the East Surrey Regt. in 1899; served in the South African War (twice Mentioned in Despatches) and Nandi Expedition (with the 3rd King's African Rifles).
