# WILLIAM BRETT ST. LEGER

Military Cross

2nd Bn., Coldstream Guards who died on 27 April 1918 Age 23

Son of Major R. A. St. Leger (S.A.M.C.), of George, Cape Province. Student at Cape Town, but left school to serve in G.S.W.A. campaign with the Cape Town Highlanders, in which he was a corporal. Afterwards he went to England and trained with the Inns of Court O.T.C. for a commission.
