HUGH FREDERICK RALEIGH AMESBURY

5th Bn. attd. "D" Coy. 8th Bn., Bedfordshire Regiment who died on 20 November 1917 Age 27

Born at Gujranwala, Punjab, India. Son of Major Frederick Cholmondeley Dering Amesbury (Indian Army), and of Henrietta Ferris Amesbury, husband of Emma Mary Amesbury, of London. Served with 1st Division Canadian Expeditionary Force at Ypres and on the Somme. Wounded at Thiepval July, 1916.
