# CHARLES HERBERT COLLET

Distinguished Service Order, Twice Mentioned in Despatches

3rd Wing, Royal Naval Air Service who died on 19 August 1915 Age 27

Son of James Francis Herbert and Teresa Collet (nee Pilley), of "Woodleigh," Westend, Southampton. Successfully carried out the first long distance air raid into enemy territory of the war, when he bombed the Zeppelin sheds at Dusseldorf on 22nd Sept. 1914.
