WILLIAM FREDERICK MATTHEWS

1st Bn., South Wales Borderers who died on 18 August 1918 Age 31

Born at Tickhill, Yorks. Son of Maj. Norman H. Matthews, T.D., and Anna Mary Matthews, of Ashley, near Market Harborough. Also served in India and West Africa. The Headstone also bears the name of Capt. John B. Matthews, M.C., N. Staffordshire Regt. attd. Leicestershire Regt. Killed in action near Polygon Wood, 2nd Oct., 1917. Age 26 years.
