Educated at Denstone College, Staffordshire (member of O.T.C. 3 years, VI. Form, Senior Prefect; Editor "Denstonian.") Balliol College, Oxon, O.C.B., 1916. commissioned Jan., 1917. (From Ingolstadt, July, 1924.).
